

Richland tops Walla Walla

WALLA WALLA — Zach Whitby hit Gibson McGeorge with a 6-yard touchdown pass with 6:31 left in the game to give Richland the lead for good in a 26-20 Mid-Columbia Conference football game at Borleske Stadium on Friday.

The Bombers trailed 20-13 going into the fourth quarter after the Blue Devils scored all 20 of their points in the third quarter.

Jonah Hoe, who rushed for 131 yards for Wa-Hi, scored on runs of 11 and 2 yards.

But Richland's Josh Phillips — who scored in the second quarter on a 50-yard run — tied the game at 20-all early in the final quarter when he scored on a 10-yard run.
