## Seven turnovers contribute to Ferris' postseason defeat

And it didn't get any better for Ferris in the second half as the Bombers throttled the Saxons 35-7 in a State 4A play-in football game on Fridgy night at Joe All the County of the Coun

na knocked out visiting Conzaga Prep 42-14.
Richland (9-1) outplayed Fer-ris (8-2) in most facets.
'It was a tough night,' Ferris coach Jim Sharkey said. 'They are a very good football team and I knew that. We knew on film that we had our hands full. We just can't turn the ball over like that and expect to wen a like that and expect to win a

game."
Ferris finished with seven
turnovers, but Sharkey wouldn't
use the mistakes as an excuse.

turned into a 21-0 Richland lead

Ferris appeared as if it would score first, using 11 plays to move 60 yards before turning the ball over on downs at Richland's 22-yard line with 4:53 to go in the

first quarter.
Richland, behind bulldozing running back Anthony Galat, methodically moved the ball over 15 plays and 80 yards with Nathan Perry scoring from 2 yards out with 10:33 to go in the second quarter.

Then the first of two big Saxons turnovers happened when wide receiver Tim Kirby fum-bled, giving the Bombers pos-session at the Ferris 32.

Five plays later, Bombers quarterback Zach Whitby hit Mason Nelson with a 13-yard TD

pass as Nelson got past Ferris cornerback Jalen Hicks for a 14-0 lead.

On the ensuing kickoff, Cole
Karstetter muffed the catch and
the ball bounded toward the
goal line. Karstetter tried to
jump on the ball and it squirted
away into the end zone where
the Bombers' Lakota Willis
pounced on it for a TD.
Just like that, it was Richland
21-0 with 7:59 to go before intermission.

To the Saxons' credit, they bounced back with their best ofbounced back with their best of-fensive series, On third-and-5 at their 46. Karstetter passed out of the double-wing set to a wide-open Hicks, who gained 39 to Richland's 15. Karstetter sprint-ed up the gut 15 yards on the next play for the touchdown. Ferris lost all three of its fum-bles in the first half. The Saxons couldn't turn the

Four Richland running backs combined for 255 yards. Whithy completed 9 of 21 passes for 147 Karstetter finished with 73

Karstetter finished with 73 yards on 12 carries.
