Wa-Hi scores big win over Bombers

Cornado on target at QB with 3 TDs; Othello rolls to win

Trevor Cornado was 14-for-17 passing for 163 yards and three touchdowns, leading the Walla Walla Blue Devils to a 34-0 win over the visiting Richland Bombers in a Mid-Columbia Conference contest Friday night at Borleske Stadium.

Cornado found Reid Magnaghi for a pair of short TD throws and Mitchell Huffman for an 11-yard score. Huffman also found the end zone on a 14-yard run.

The Blue Devils defense limited Richland to just 91 yards for the game.
