

## MID-COLUMBIA REPLAY

On this day in ...

**1998:** Lance Kostoff kicked a 26-yard field goal, Kurt Morgan scored on a 9-yard rush and Josh Shimek hit Kyle Nelson on a 15-yard pass as Pasco beat Wilson of Tacoma 17-0 to earn the Class 4A football championship at the Tacoma Dome.

**1994:** Prosser's Andy Harris was selected the Class AA all-state player of the year by the state's sports writers. Harris, a linebacker and running back, was the only non-quarterback in the five classes to be named the top player. He ran for 1,220 yards and 26 touchdowns, but the two-time defend-

ing state champion Mustangs lost in the quarterfinals to West Valley of Yakima, 11-9, snapping a 36-game winning streak.

**1981:** Richland's Mark Schwisow took a short pass from Mark Birchler and broke off an 81-yard score with 2:42 left in the game, lifting the Bombers to a 7-6 win over Kentridge in the Class AAA state championship at the Kingbowl. Tim Ruane's extra point proved the margin of victory, and Kyle Kafentzis' ensuing interception put the game away. "We finally did it," coach J.D. Covington said, a year after his team lost 28-26 in the semifinals. "It was a great team win."
