Richland sweeps aside Wa-Hi

Bombers score 24
unanswered points,
move to 3-0 in MCC

Lakota Wills scored two rushing touchdowns, and Alex Chapman scored on a 59-yard touchdown pass from Paxton Stevens as the Richland High School football team improved to 3-0 in the Mid-Columbia Conference with a 31-19 home win over Walla Walla on Friday night.

Wa-Hi cut Richland's lead to 7-6 before the Bombers scored the next 24 points to take a 31-6 lead midway through the fourth quarter. The Blue Devils tacked on two late scores, including an interception return for a touchdown.

Richland is tied with Kamiakin (4-1, 3-0) for the MCC lead. The two teams will meet on Friday, Oct. 23, in a game that is expected to decide the conference title.
