Chiawana, Richland remain unbeaten with big victories

■The fourth-ranked **Riverhawks pound Pasco** 49-0, while the No. 2 **Bombers trounce Walla** Walla 64-14.

Andrew Vargas ran for 215 yards and six touchdowns, and the Chiawana Riverhawks manhandled their city rivals Friday night for a 49-0 win over the Pasco Bulldogs in the Gravel Pit Bowl at Edgar Brown Stadium.

The Riverhawks (7-0 overall, 5-0 Mid-Columbia Conference) barely budged an inch on defense, giving up just 27 yards on 20 carries to the Bulldogs (0-7, 0-5) and 54 yards total. Meanwhile, Chiawana bulldozed about the field for 236 yards on 31 rushes.

Vargas' touchdown total for the season grew to 32. He has rushed for 1,858 vards on 181 carries.

Quarterback Troy Simpkins was a sharp 9-of-12 passing for 102 yards, with Josiah Richardson catching four balls for 52 yards.

Trent Simpkins notched the game's final score on a 46-yard punt return.

Deondre Hendrix authored what little success Pasco had on offense, rushing for 41 yards on 14 carries and also catching one pass from 12 yards. Both were team highs.

The Class 4A fourthranked Riverhawks remain unblemished heading into next week's matchup with No. 2 Richland at Edgar Brown Stadium. Both teams are unbeaten.

cluding TD passes of 13, 25 and 77 yards from Paxton Stevens. Weissenfels also kicked eight PATs and returned an interception 38 yards for a touchdown.

Parker McCary led the Bombers' ground game with 133 yards on 11 carries. He scored on runs of 3, 1 and 63 yards.

Walla Walla (3-4, 2-3) opened the game with a 3-yard run by Mitch Lesmeister for a 7-0 lead, then led 14-7 with another 3-yard run by Lesmeister. But that would be all for the Blue Devils, who were held to 109 yards of offense.

Stevens finished 13-of-24 passing for 237 yards and

four touchdowns, including a 33-yard throw to Kody Kjarmo that opened the scoring for Richland. Bombers backup Cade Jensen completed all three of his passes for 45 yards.

While Richland will face Chiawana on Friday night, Walla Walla plays Kamiakin in a Thursday night contest at Lampson Stadium.
