Richland holds at No. 2, Chiawana down to eighth in AP state poll

Last week's Richland-Chiawana football game shook up the state rankings a bit.

The Richland Bombers, who beat Chiawana 21-14 at Edgar Brown Stadium to improve to 8-0 overall, didn't budge from the No. 2 spot in The Associated Press Class 4A state poll, released Wednesday. But they tallied 90 points, just seven behind No. 1 Camas (8-0).

Also, the Bombers received three first-place votes after not getting any the previous two weeks.

With its first loss of the season, Chiawana sank from fourth to eighth. The River-

hawks (7-1) got 34 points, just nine more than 10th-place Monroe, an 8-0 team from the Wesco. But in The Seattle Times 4A power rankings, Richland held at No. 2 and Chiawana at No. 10.

Kamiakin (6-2), which will face Southridge on Thursday at Lampson Stadium for the Mid-Columbia Conference Class 3A title, moved up a spot to No. 5 in the AP poll. The Braves defeated Walla Walla 48-21 last Thursday. Kamiakin held steady at No. 7 in the Times 3A rankings.

Meanwhile, 2A Prosser (7-1) stayed at No. 5 in the AP poll and at No. 6 in the Times rankings. The Mustangs play Friday at Othello.

While Royal (8-0) remained the unanimous No. 1 in the 1A AP rankings, Connell (7-1) slipped a spot to No. 3 — one point behind behind Mount Baker (8-0).

In the 2B AP rankings, Dayton-Waitsburg (7-1) stood pat at No. 9.
