The top of the 4A classification saw plenty of change in The Seattle Times state football rankings.

The top two teams from the preseason rankings, No. 1 Gonzaga Prep and No. 2 Skyline, lost their season openers last week and tumbled to No. 6 and 8, respectively. Gonzaga Prep lost to Class 3A No. 1 Eastside Catholic 21-7. Skyline fell at Richland, which moved up from No. 5 to No. 1, 38-27.

Gonzaga Prep and Skyline play a rematch of last year's Class 4A state championship game (won by the Bullpups 34-16) in Spokane on Friday.

The top of the Class 3A and 2A polls remained mostly unchanged.
